Empty your car before someone else does

Devon and Cornwall Police are urging Christmas shoppers to be on their guard for opportunist thieves looking for presents left in vehicles.

As the festive period approaches, police are recommending that people take care by keeping car windows closed and doors locked, and by keeping presents and valuables out of sight. PCSO Kingdon said: "Theft from vehicles in Devon and Cornwall remains low but the opportunity for this type of crime traditionally rises during Christmas.

"Shoppers should be aware and keep purchases with them rather than leave them on display in vehicles. This will reduce the opportunity for crime."

Police suggest shoppers follow simple precautions when out and about during the festive season:

- Lock your vehicles and close windows.
- Park in a well-lit and recognised car park.
- Leave nothing on display in your vehicle.
- Plan shopping so that bulky items are collected at the end of the day rather than being stored in your vehicle.
- When you get home make a note of any serial numbers of valuable items on the guarantee slip.
- Register valuables using the free service at www.immobilise.com which enables police
