**Volunteers constantly say that they get more than they give through their volunteer work. Often, they talk about coming away from the experience feeling great— physically, emotionally, intellectually and socially.**



### How you can help?

#### 1. Service our collection boxes

The Charity has almost 5,000 red collection boxes permanently sited at outlets throughout the county. Last year the total collected, in small change, was over £175,000. Our box collectors are therefore very important to us. We ask our box collectors to service each of their boxes at least twice a year.

#### 2. Help in our shops

We now have 17 shops across Devon; Barnstaple, Bideford, Exeter (Furniture & Electrical Store, Heavitree, Cowick Street & Topsham x 2), Exmouth, Honiton, Kingsbridge, Newton Abbot, Sidmouth, Plymouth, Tavistock, Totnes, Budleigh Salterton and South Molton.



#### 3. Give talks

Talks are often requested by small community groups and our volunteers take along a PowerPoint presentation to promote our work, encourage support from local people and raise money.



#### 4. Help in our offices

We have several volunteering opportunities in our office; from regular help on reception to helping with the admin for one-off events like our annual Grand Summer Draw or occasional help with deliveries.



#### 4. Attend events

This could be anything from running a stall, promoting us and selling our merchandise at a country fete, taking part in a community event or helping at one of DAA's annual events -Commando Challenge, Dragon Boat Festival or Motorcycle Ride Out.



#### 5. Attend cheque presentations

Thanks to the generosity of local people volunteers are often needed to collect cheques from fundraising events. These could be for a group like the WI, a Council meeting, pub quiz or coffee morning. People who have raised money for us really appreciate a volunteer going along to support them, and it's great publicity for their group and for us!



#### 6. Drive our van between shops delivering stock

We are looking for volunteers to take van loads of stock between our shops. We may also ask you to deliver buckets and banners to people holding events for us and to pick up and replace full collecting tins from outlets around the county.
